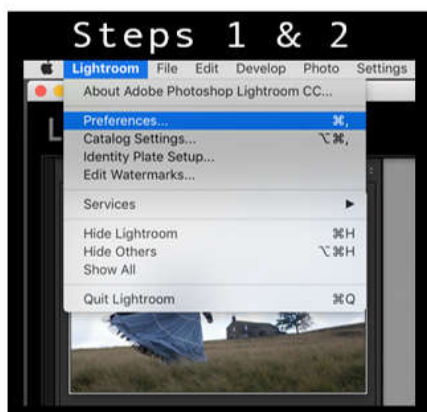


JD Looking Glass Presets

Installation Instructions for Lightroom

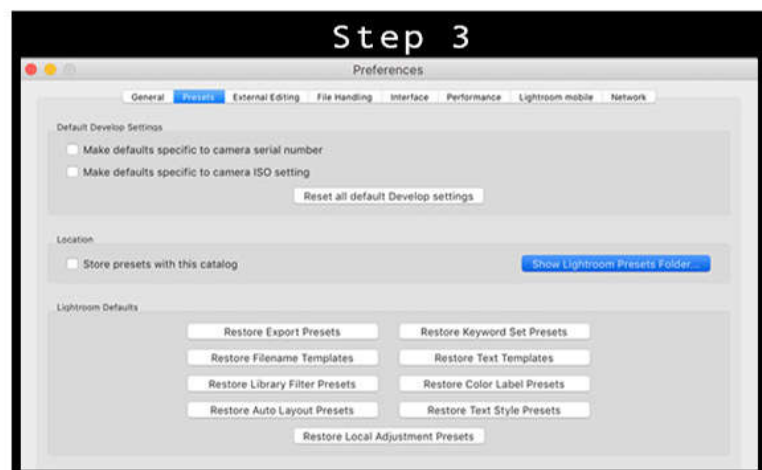


First, please unzip the .zip folder you've downloaded.

1. In LR, click on the menu "Edit" (Windows) or "Lightroom" (Mac).

2. Choose "Preferences" and then click on the tab "Presets".

3. Click the "Show Lightroom Presets Folder" button.

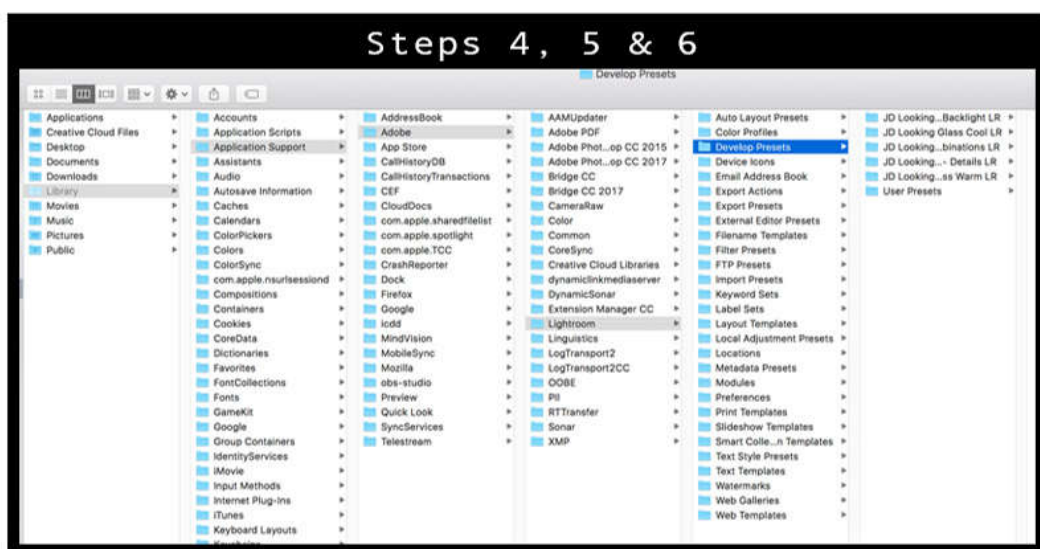


4. Open the folder called Lightroom.

5. Open the folder called "Develop Presets".

6. Copy and paste here the files you have found in your unzipped folder.

Restart Lightroom and Have Fun!

Installation Instructions for Adobe Camera Raw

First of all, please unzip the .zip folder.

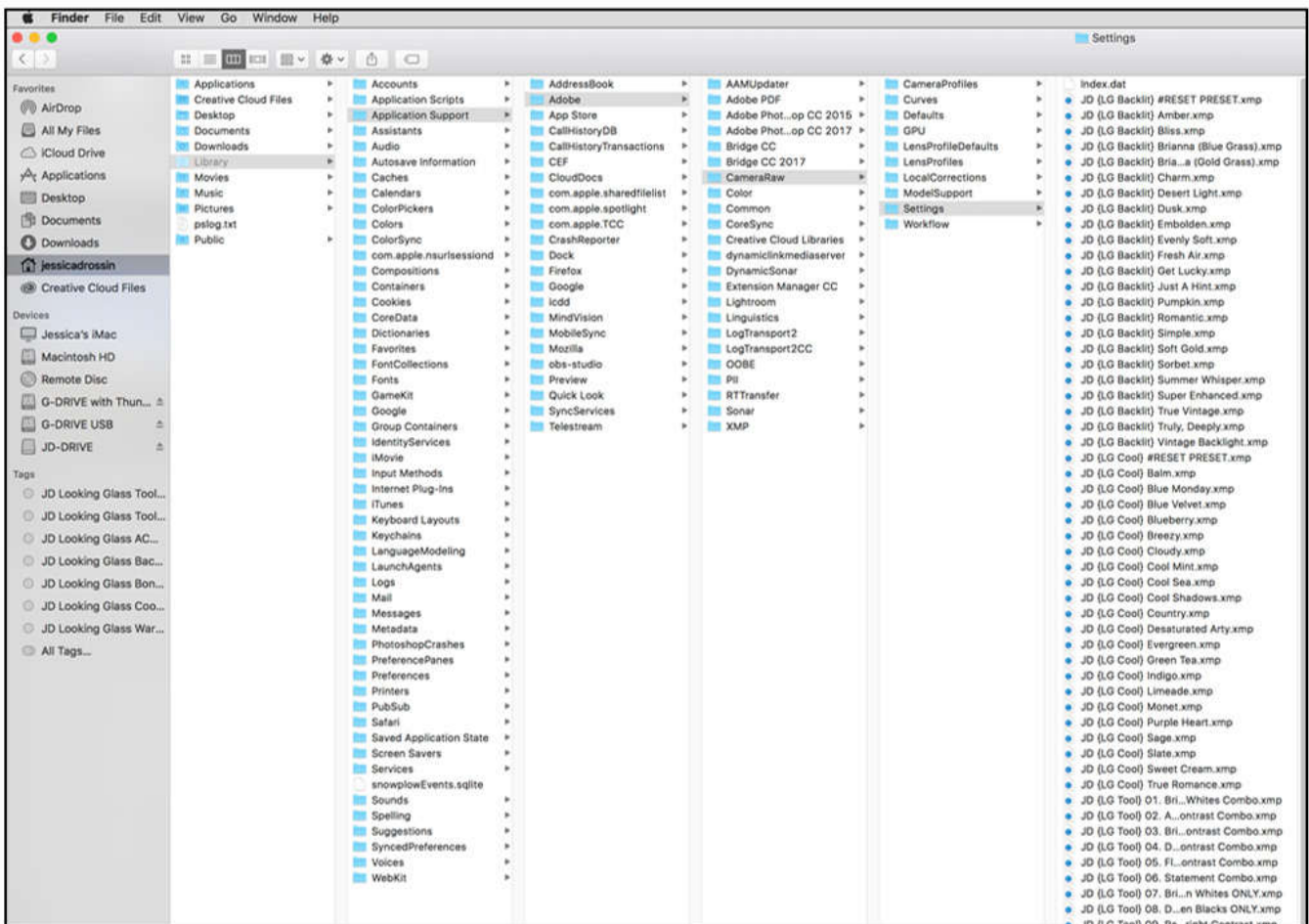
MAC:

1. Open the unzipped folder, select all the presets (they are ONLY .xmp files) and copy them.
2. Navigate to (user)/Library/Application Support/Adobe/CameraRaw/Settings

If you can't find the Library, hold the Option key down while selecting the Go menu in Finder, and it should appear.

3. Make sure you are in the Settings folder, then paste the files you had previously copied.

You can now open ACR and enjoy your presets!

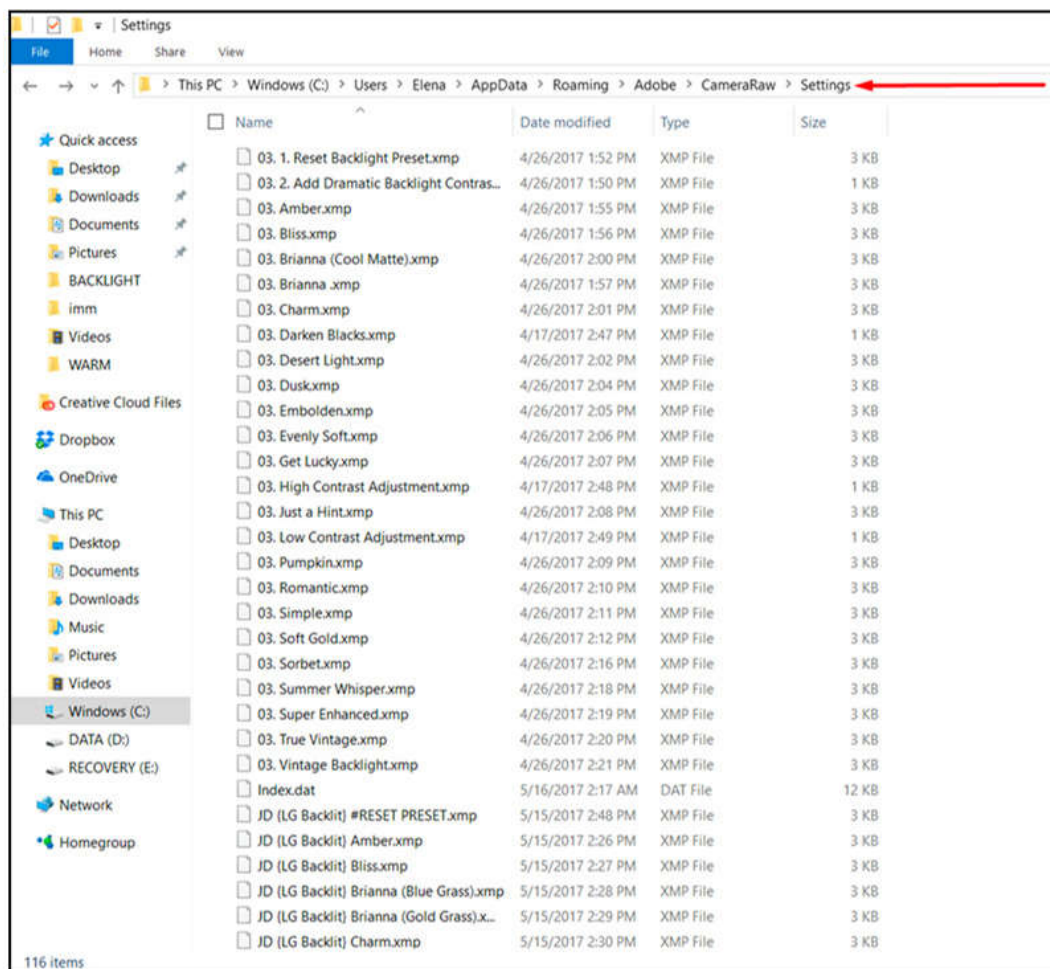
Installation Instructions for Adobe Camera Raw

First of all, please unzip the .zip folder.

WINDOWS:

1. Open the unzipped folder, select all the presets (they are ONLY .xmp files) and copy them.
2. Navigate to C:\Users*(User - this being your username)*\AppData\Roaming\Adobe\CameraRaw\Settings
If you can't find the AppData folder, make it visible by simply clicking the View tab and ticking "Hidden items" (Windows 10 or 8). On Windows 7 or earlier, select Organize > Folders and search options, click on the View tab, then scroll till you see the Show hidden files, folders and drives option. Apply and click the OK button.
3. Make sure you are in the Settings folder, then paste the files you had previously copied.

You can now open ACR and enjoy your presets!



JD Looking Glass Actions

Installation Instructions for Photoshop CC

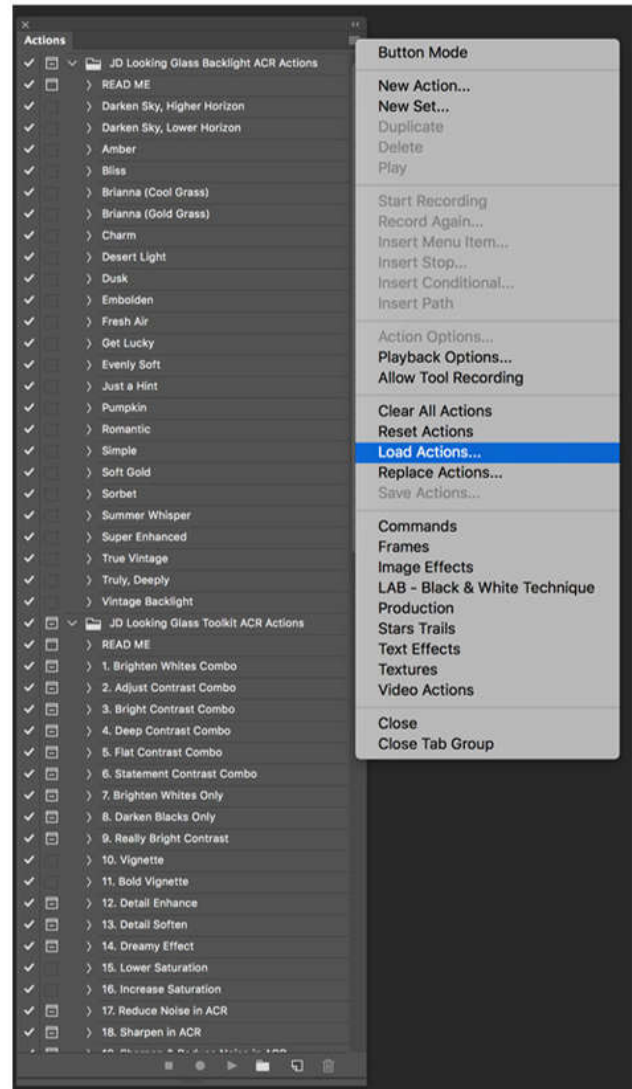
First of all, please unzip the .zip folder.

1. Make sure you have installed the ACR presets as described in this tutorial. If the presets are not installed these actions **WILL NOT WORK**.

2. One way to install is to simply click on the icon or the action's name in the folder once you've downloaded and unzipped it.

3. Another way to install actions is to go to your actions panel in Photoshop, then click the top right corner. A drop down menu will appear, select the option "Load Actions". A search bar will come up. Simply locate where you have saved your actions, select them, and hit "OK". You will now see your actions in the actions palette.

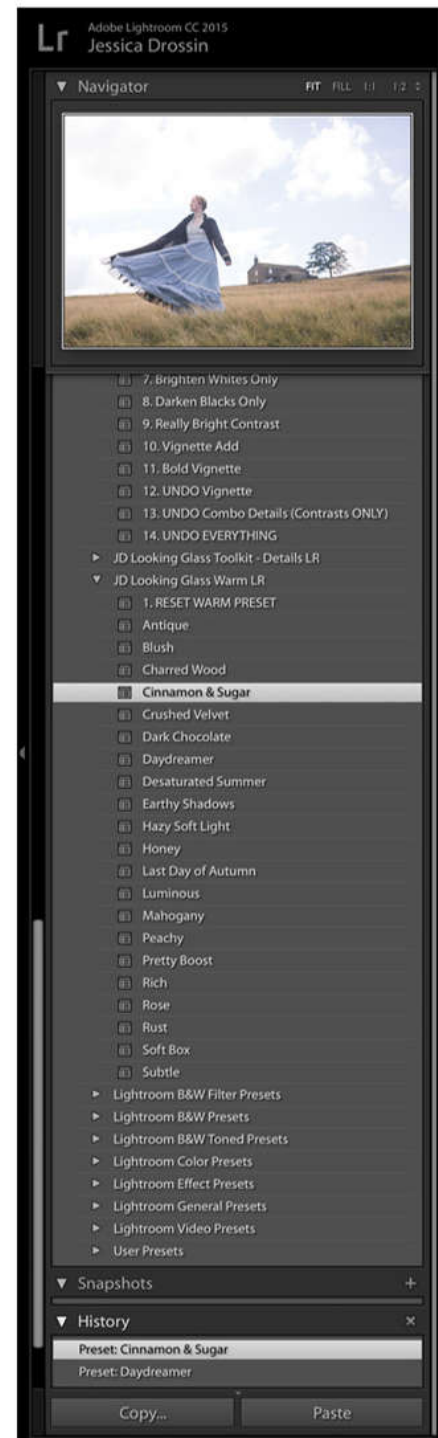
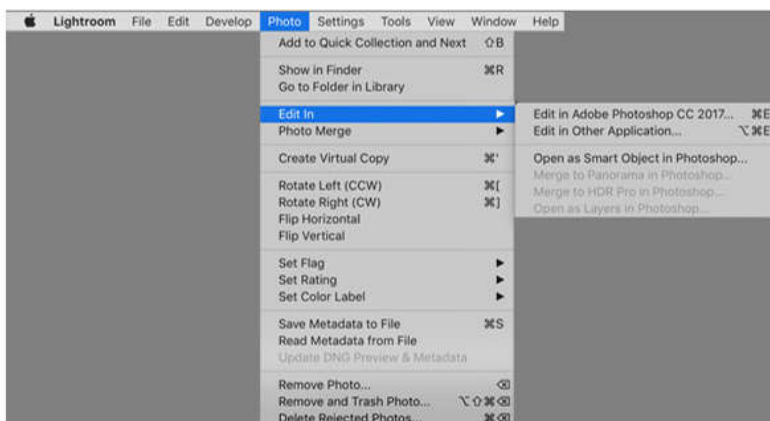
4. Please remember to back up your actions on an external drive.



Frequently Asked Questions

Lightroom

1. I recommend starting with the preset tones, however, you can use the Toolkit presets alone.
2. Preset tones will “override” Toolkit contrasts, this is why I suggest using them first. If you liked the original tone in the preset better than any of the Toolkit contrast options, simply reselect the original tone preset and it will revert. You can also use the History palette in Lightroom (you must be in the Develop mode).
3. To undo everything except for any crops, clones, etc., simply select the “UNDO EVERYTHING” preset in the Toolkit palette.
4. To export to Photoshop, simply go to Lightroom Menu, then select “Photo”, “Edit In”, and select “Edit in Photoshop”.



Frequently Asked Questions

Photoshop CC

1. Due to their nature, these actions simply pull up the presets, most do not contain individual transparent adjustment layers.

2. Once you are familiar with how the actions work, if you would like to disable the reminder message, simply “unclick” the check next to the word “Stop” in the action’s drop down menu.

3. For the actions to work properly, if you get a message asking you to select the correct layer, make sure that layer is turned on. The actions will not work properly if you run the action while a turned off layer is selected.

4. The actions will NOT work if you do not have the ACR presets installed properly.
